### **Scope**

Henrizi-Schneider American Legion Post 382 in conjunction with the National American Legion Charter and The Four Pillars of the American Legion offer this **Post 382 Academic Scholarship** for our members of the Post, Post Auxiliary and Post S.A.L. This program is intended to assist applicants from our Post 382 Family pursue higher education to achieve their goals.

### **Applicant Criteria**

Applicants must be a senior in High School graduating in the year the award is granted. Applicants must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, stepchild or adopted child of a Member in Good Standing in Henrizi-Schneider American League Post 382, American Legion Auxiliary Unit 382 or Sons of The American Legion Squadron 382. Applicants must submit an essay of 450-500 words addressing:

**“What a life of civic services means to you based on experiences and conversations with your Military connected family.”**

Essays will be judged by the American Legion Post 382 Scholarship Committee.

### **Applicable Education Institute**

The American Legion Post 382 Academic Scholarship can be used for any education institution, public or private, that provides structured learning encompassing formal settings like universities, colleges, vocational centers, trade schools, technical institutes and business schools focused on knowledge acquisition, skill development and personal growth.
